## Some of the things you said we do well.......

- 1. Families said we care about the children, and they are taught well
- 2. That teaching assistants provide excellent support to pupils
- 3. Classroom teaching is 'first class'
- 4. Our school is inclusive and provides good support
- 5. That the school has improved over time
- 6. Pupils really enjoy our focus/theme weeks (Art week etc)

## ....and areas for development

- 1. Families want to see the return of inter-school sport fixtures.
- 2. We could improve our celebration and publicity of children's achievements and talents.
- 3. We could improve our offer for personal development and enrichment (to build back some of the things that stopped during the pandemic) Families mentioned outdoor learning and practical activities.



- 4. Some families felt they didn't know enough about what their child was learning, and would appreciate more information on this.
- 5. Some families felt that we could improve our communication to ensure it is consistent and helpful for everyone.

## As a result, these are the things we are going to do to address these development points

- 1. Plan to re-connect with local sports fixtures to give children the experience of joining in with these again.
- 2. Develop a plan to showcase children's achievements, and ensure all children are challenged and celebrated for their unique talents, or skills.
- 3. Develop the range of activities we offer for pupils throughout their primary school career such as trips and visits, cultural experiences, and visitors in to school.
- 4. Develop a communication policy, to ensure everyone has the information they need consistently.
- 5. Hold further events on the curriculum.
